

Evacuation

➡ Use escape routes.

➡ Join the meeting point.

As soon as the alarm rings,

help people with reduced mobility.

➡ Wait for the firefighter's instructions.

Registration: all visitors must register at the reception to be provided with a personal visitor's badge, which must be worn and visible at all times. At their departure, visitors must return their badge at the reception.


<mark>₿</mark> Fire

- Raise the alarm by pressing a manual fire button which is located along the escape route or near the fire cabinets.
- Rescue: assist people with reduced mobility, evacuate the dangerous areas.
- ➡ Act: fight the fire, if safe to do so.

Accident

In case of medical emergency such as wound, injury, faintness, dial **+41 (0)32 729 6000** (or 5555 from a landline) to alert the First Aid Team. Provide as much information as possible and stay with the person.
