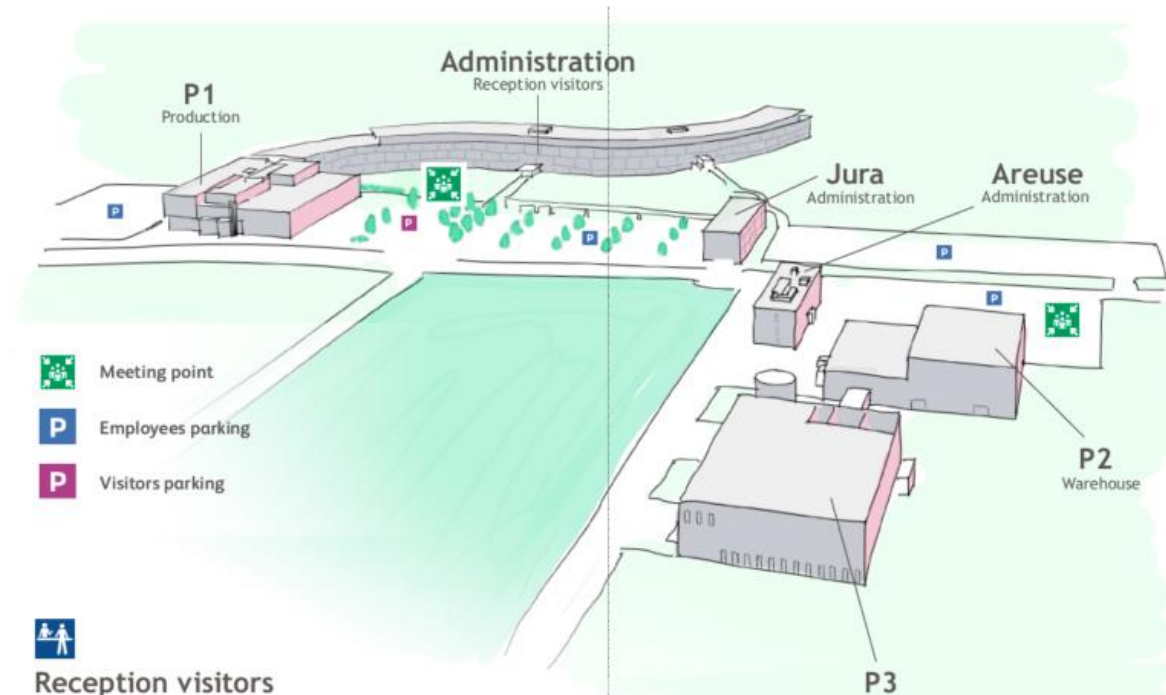

## Reception visitors

Registration: all visitors must register at the reception to be provided with a personal visitor's badge, which must be worn and visible at all times. At their departure, visitors must return their badge at the reception.




## Fire

- **Raise the alarm** by pressing a manual fire button which is located along the escape route or near the fire cabinets.
- **Rescue:** assist people with reduced mobility, evacuate the dangerous areas.
- **Act:** fight the fire, if safe to do so.



## Evacuation




-  As soon as the alarm rings, everyone must evacuate the building.
- **Use escape routes,** help people with reduced mobility.
- **Join the meeting point.**  
For Areuse, P2 and P3, on the parking lot next to P2  
For P1, Administration and Jura, on visitors parking
- **Wait for the firefighter's instructions.**



## Accident

In case of medical emergency such as wound, injury, faintness, dial **+41 (0)32 729 6000** (or 5555 from a landline) to alert the First Aid Team. Provide as much information as possible and stay with the person.
